

CARDIOVASCULAR MEDICATION REFERENCE LIST and STATIN THERAPY GUIDE

Four classes of medications are recommended as first-line therapies for hypertension:

Thiazide diuretics

- Common medication: Hydrochlorothiazide

Calcium channel blockers (CCB)

- Common medication: Amlodipine

Angiotensin-converting enzyme inhibitors (ACEI)

- Common medication: Lisinopril

Angiotensin receptor blockers (ARB)

- Common medication: Losartan

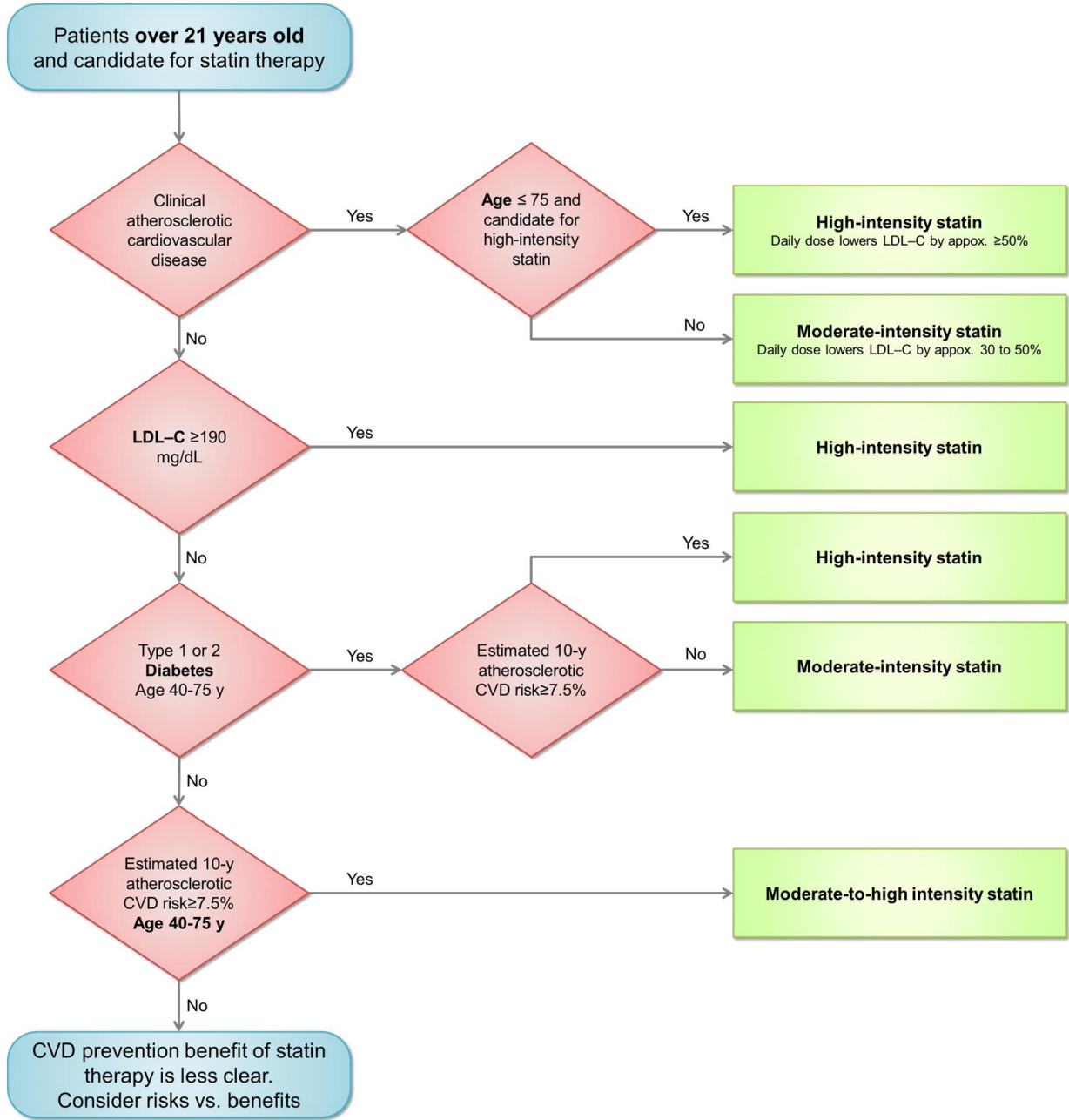
Statin Guidelines:

High-Intensity Statins	LDL-C \geq 50%
Generic	Brand Name
Atorvastatin 40-80 mg	Lipitor
Rosuvastatin 20-40 mg	Crestor

Moderate-Intensity Statins	LDL-C = 30% - 50%
Generic	Brand Name
Atorvastatin 10-20 mg	Lipitor
Rosuvastatin 5-10 mg	Crestor
Simvastatin 20-40 mg	Zocor
Pravastatin 40-80 mg	Pravachol
Lovastatin 40 mg	Altoprev
Fluvastatin 40 mg BID	Lescol & Lescol XL
Pitavastatin 2-4 mg	Livalo

Low-Intensity Statins	LDL-C < 30%
Generic	Brand Name
Simvastatin 10 mg	Zocor
Pravastatin 10-20 mg	Pravachol
Lovastatin 20 mg	Altoprev
Fluvastatin 20-40 mg	Lescol & Lescol XL
Pitavastatin 1 mg	Livalo
